#### **Day 1 Seoul City Tour**

Itinerary: Firstly, have breakfast; your day will start from the places of Seoul City. You will be exploring places like GYEONGBOKGUNG PALACE, ROYAL **GUARD CHANGING BLUE** CEREMONY, HOUSE, CHEONGGYECHEON STREAM, **BUKCHON** HANOK VILLAGE, INSADONG ARTS AND CRAFTS MARKET, N SEOUL TOWER and others after breakfast. Dinner is at an Indian restaurant in the Yongsan district. Overnight stay in the city.

Gyeongbokgung Palace to experience the most representative edifices of the Joseon Dynasty (more than 500 years old).

Afterwards, visit the **National Folk Museum** to learn about Korea's unique culture and how Koreans used to live in the olden days. Continuing onwards, we will enjoy a quick stop to witness the Traditional Royal Guard Changing Ceremony and the Presidential Blue House before arriving at the famous Bukchon Hanok Village.

Bukchon Hanok Village is a Korean traditional village in Seoul with a long history, located on the top of a hill between Gyeongbok Palace, Changdeok Palace and Jongmyo Royal Shrine. The traditional village is composed of many alleys and hanoks, which are preserved to show a 600-year-old urban environment. Here you will enjoy a guided walk and marvel

at the beautiful traditional homes. After visiting the Bukchon Hanok village, you will take part in a cooking class preparing Korea's number one staple dish - Kimchi. During this class, you will also have the opportunity to take photos of the Korean traditional outfit Hanbok.

#### **Day 2 DMZ Tour**

The **DMZ Tour** is a journey to the Demilitarized Zone, the site of the Korean War fighting between North and South Korea. You will be amazed to see many memorials and monuments that symbolize peace and friendship between the countries. Your tour will start at IMJINGAK PAVILION, THE UNIFICATION BRIDGE and THE 3RD

**OBSERVATORY**, and finally back to SEOUL for a delicious dinner at an Indian restaurant.

The next morning, head north towards the North Korean border. When you arrive at the DMZ Take a guided tour of Imjingak Resort. . The resort is home to its Freedom Bridge and Imjingang rail bridge dating back to the Korean War to remind people of their past, with the Memorial Hall, memorial monuments and the bell that rang out to announce the unification ceremony Last Train Out, The Bridge of No Return, and recreation areas. After that, you'll go through security checks for passports and then enjoy a brief introduction to the United Nations camp.

After visit The Dora that, you can Observatory which is on the South Korean side of the 38th parallel. It is located at the top of Dorasan in Paju the Observatory offers stunning views of the entire Demilitarized Zone. Visitors can view North Korea from the North Korean territory through binoculars from the 304 square feet observatory with a capacity of 500 persons. After that, head towards Dorasan railway station which once served as a link between North Korea and South Korea and was later restored.

After that, visit **Imjingak Park** with the Memorial and as well as the Liberty Bridge, and the bell for the unification. The tour will conclude by visiting the Third Tunnel of Aggression, which is among four tunnels that

are known to exist that lie that separates North Korea and South Korea that has been built into the rock to an altitude of 73m. It is capable of holding a full army division every hour using its weapons.

#### Day 3 Seoul/Nami Island/Gangwon

Today, you will start your tour with breakfast at the hotel. Then, you will visit NAMI ISLAND, PETITE FRANCE and drive to GANGWON DO where you will experience the beautiful beaches and even enjoy surfing. After that, you will head to an Indian restaurant for dinner and finally, return back to your hotel for a good night's rest.

#### Day 4 - Gangwon-Do
